- Beginning 12:30 until 01:45 PM
- Distance: ca. 300 meter
- 40 participants = 20 races (duel)
- The fastest drivers (all in all) compete for the World Championship in the final

#### **2. Skills**

- Beginning 02:15 until 03:30 PM
- Distance: ca. 200 meter
- Parcours

#### **3. Endurance**

- Beginning 04:00 until 05:15 PM
- Distance: 1,7 kilometer

#### **4. Award Ceremony**

- Beginning 05.30 PM
- BERLINER BANK Velotaxi WM on stage
- World Champion Ceremony  
(through Mr Bortz or Mr Gilly and Dr. Anselm Franz)
